A MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS IN CHRIST,

FATHER BAKER'S PILGRIMAGE TO FRANCE & ITALY 1874 RE-ENACTED IN 2024:

As a seminarian at Our Lady of the Angels Seminary in Niagara Falls, then-Nelson Baker requested from the Bishop and the Seminary Rector permission to participate in an American Pilgrimage specifically to Paris & Lourdes, France and then onto Rome, Italy to St. Peter's Basilica and the Shrines of the Apostles. Father Baker desired to use this pilgrimage as an opportunity to thank God for his physical recovery from a very serious illness and to visit the famous shrines of Europe.

On May 13, Father Baker departed by train from Buffalo to New York City to join the other pilgrims from across the country. On May 16, after Mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral, the pilgrims boarded the ship, *S.S. Periere*, which set course for France. On May 27, the *Periere* reached Le Havre, and then continued on to Paris, arriving on May 28, and then eventually to Rome and then began their return home on June 21, eventually arriving back in NYC on July 15, 1874.

It was while Father Baker was on this pilgrimage that he visited the Church of Notre Dame des Victoires in Paris. In the critical biography "Father of the Fatherless" this quote can be found: *He (Baker) was amazed as he entered the shrine. His eyes focused on the intensely appealing statue of a lady holding a little boy in her arms atop the main altar...He knelt at the communion rail, still gazing at the statue. And then his words came in a torrent of whispers: "From now on I shall devote my entire life to your service. I shall devote all my thoughts and actions to your name, I will spread devotion of Our Lady of Victory throughout America."* And as we know here in Father Baker's City of Charity, that is exactly what he did. We are all the beneficiaries of Father



Baker's profound love and devotion for Our Lady of Victory.

I am leaving on Tuesday, April 30 – May 8, along with 34 pilgrims, to re-enact the journey Father Baker took back in 1874. However, rather than traveling by ship, we will depart New York City by plane on Tuesday evening for Paris, France. Our journey will begin with 2 nights in Lourdes, celebrating Mass and praying at the Grotto, and then back to Paris, where the highlight of the pilgrimage will be celebrating Mass at Notre Dame des Victoires on Friday, May 3. Please know that I will be offering this Mass for all of our parishioners, donors and benefactors of Our Lady of Victory National Shrine & Basilica. We then proceed onto Rome arriving on Sunday, May 5. Highlights will be celebrating Masses at St. Peter's Basilica, the Basilica of St. Paul Outside the Wall, the Basilica of St. Mary Major, and participating in the Wednesday General Audience with Pope Francis in St. Peter's Square.

Please pray for all of our pilgrims for a safe and grace-filled pilgrimage. Be assured that you will all be remembered in my daily Masses and

prayers. May Father Baker intercede for us and Our Lady of Victory protect us.

MAY CROWNING, Sunday, May 12 (Mother's Day)

On Sunday, May 12, during the 12:00 Noon Mass, we will have the crowning of the statue of Our Lady of Victory. Children who have recently received their First Holy Communion are encouraged to attend this Mass wearing their First Communion attire. All are welcome!

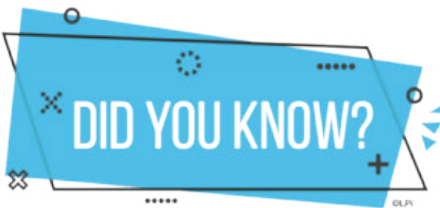

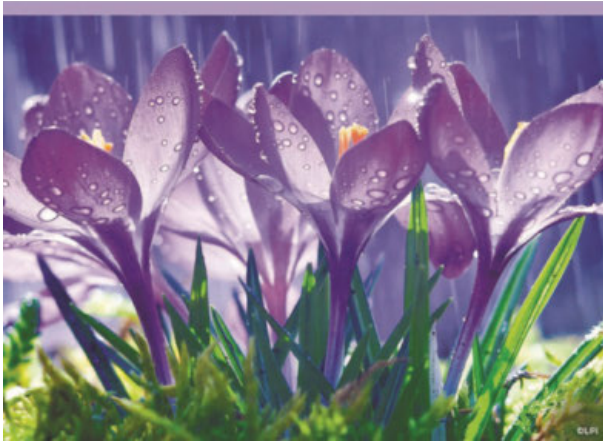
